

Sai Baba's Gurusthan

This is a small place under the blessed **Margosa tree** towards the west of the Samadhi temple. Shri Sai was first seen sitting under this tree in the outskirts of the village of Shirdi. Later Baba himself referred this as a Holy and sanctified resting-place of his spiritual `ancestor' or Master. T

herefore, this place is known as `Gurusthan' or **Abode of the Master**. While going or coming from **Lendi garden** Baba used to bow to this place from a distance. The leaves of this neem tree are said to have lost its bitterness. This old neem tree is guarded and maintained by the Trust today.

There is a small temple erected under this tree with a portrait of Sai Baba, a small idol of Him and `sacred feet' of the Master.
